SAFE SITTER® INSTRUCTOR QUALIFICATIONS

Safe Sitter® Instructors must meet the following qualifications:

- Teach under the direction of a Safe Sitter® Site Coordinator at a Registered Safe Sitter® Teaching Site.
- Be at least 18 years old with a high school diploma or equivalent.
- Have 2 years of experience in health care, child care (including parenting), or youth work.
- Hold a current certification in a CPR class, such as Heartsaver® CPR/AED from the American Heart Association.
- Enjoy teaching young teens and being a role model.
- Commit to teaching at least one class per year.
- Complete Safe Sitter® Instructor Training.
- To teach CPR in a Safe Sitter® Class, you must either be current in a CPR Instructor course or use the Safe Sitter® CPR Video to teach that section of the class.
